



TERMS OF USE SANT PAU ART NOUVEAU SITE


Sant Pau Art Nouveau Site was declared a World Heritage Site by the UNESCO, so these rules must to be followed to assure the good conservation of this unique venue:

- It is not allowed to exceed the overload of use of each plant
- Do not damage any Heritage element: walls, doors, pavements, ceilings, balustrade, etc.
- All furniture should be placed upon floor protection. The mosaic pavement must be protected by rigid elements, such as wooden boards or strips of neoprene.
- All the additional elements to be placed anywhere must be self-supporting, so, it is not allowed to anchor or fix anything to vertical or horizontal surfaces.
- Adhesive tapes are not allowed in any surface unless they are used above masking tape.
- The existing furniture can not be moved without the prior approval of the Maintenance Department.
- If more electrical power is needed for the event, the maintenance department will indicate where should be connected. It is strictly forbidden to connect to an electrical box without prior authorization from the maintenance department.
- If the customer wants to have their particular wi-fi, it must first be approved by the Department of Maintenance.
- The maintenance department has hired the main services such as system maintenance, cleaning, gardening, telecommunications and audiovisual to certain companies. If the customer requires to hire these services to different companies, the work needs to be supervised by the Maintenance Department.


Mandatory use of face mask
